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Minutes of a Meeting of Steventon Parish Council held on Tuesday 4th April 2017 in the Village Hall Millennium Room

1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Mrs Carole Denton, Miss Linda Humphries and Cllr S Lilly(OCC)

2. PRESENT

Dr C Wilding Chair, Mr J Bennett, Mr R Bosley, Mr J Clark, Mr R Green, Mr J Spiller and Mr R Wilkinson. Mrs A Einon (Parish Clerk) and Cllr M Barber(OCC) were in attendance. There were fifteen members of the public present.

3. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY INTERESTS AND OTHER DECLARATIONS

To receive any declarations of disclosable pecuniary interests, and other declarations, in respect of items on the agenda for this meeting.

4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4.1. Speed in Hanney Road

Concerns were expressed at the volume and speed of traffic in the Hanney Road and the size of lorries that could be felt affecting properties. The Parish Council had tried to get a zebra crossing which would slow traffic and provide safe crossing but the road has insufficient accidents for Highways to consider installation. Highways had not included the request in S106 funds from recent developments and the outline costs provided for a light controlled puffin crossing is in the order of £60,000 to £80,000 plus the costs of detailed analysis of the site. It is essential to report any incident you see to the police on 101. Applications for weight restrictions for the village were unlikely to be successful as we are the designated route if the A34 is blocked for any reason. The size of lorries accessing the Storage Depot frequently resulted in their being unable to turn from High Street into Hanney Road.

Cllr Matthew Barber agreed to raise the problem with the local police and with the County and to try to get the Hanney Road to be assessed for Environmental monitoring.

4.2. Reservoir

Dr Derek Stork, Chair of Gard, gave a presentation on the current proposals by Thames Water to build a reservoir. The plan was rejected in 2010 after a public enquiry but it has been included in the proposals for 2019-24. Thames Water have the second worst leakage rate in the UK, in that a quarter of the water supplied is lost, and they have the lowest uptake of water meters. They estimate that 30% extra water will be needed due to population growth and climate change. Reservoirs are affected by climate change unlike desalination and recycling. The proposal could mean a 50% larger reservoir than the rejected one with 100ft high walls built with untested technology and holding more water than any built without natural land contours. There would be a 25m head of water. It would take ten years to construct and if larger and phased were agreed even longer.

4.3. Railway electrification and bridge

Network Rail had not submitted the Listed Building Planning application promised by end of March. Until submission full details are not known of the case for demolition. Local businesses had not been consulted but there are outline plans for road closures for 10 months from November.

4. REPORT FROM ANY COUNTY OR DISTRICT COUNCILLOR IN ATTENDANCE

Cllr Matthew Barber agreed that the Local Plan does include provision for a reservoir, the inspector insisted it stayed, but this is not supported by the Vale. Listed building consent would be required to demolish the railway bridge, English Heritage is against and the Vale are likely to support their view. The Local Plan part 2 is out for consultation until 4th May, there are no sights for Steventon included, full details are available on the Vale website.

6. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 7th March 2017, were accepted as a true record, with correction to Bennett spelling, two tt, and clarification that item 7.1 meeting to be arranged was the same meeting as that mentioned in item 4.5 Potholes outside the School.

The appeal would be held over 4 days from 9th May anyone wishing to contribute could register on that day. Dr Wilding would attend and speak for the Parish Council, a draft to be prepared for discussion as it was likely that any statement would be cross examined by a Pye representative and the Inspector would decide on written evidence. Section 106 needed inclusion.

9.6. Village Infrastructure – Railway, Roads, Drains JB, RB, RG, JS, CW

A meeting had been held on 20th March with Network Rail, English Heritage, OCC, Ed Vaizey, s PA, and members of the Parish Council a further meeting was scheduled for 24th April. The Listed Building application, although submission suggested by end March was unlikely to be before mid-May as various key personnel had holidays arranged. It would be essential to raise Public awareness and participation in commenting on the application. The Swiss expert had costed a computer simulation in the region of £15k. Historic England and the Parish council had no funds. Possible funding by local businesses, the Enterprise Zone and Milton Park. Dr Wilding had spoken to Veronica Reynolds of Milton Park and she was very concerned about the proposed 10 month closure, she has written to Network Rail to ask why they had not been consulted. Mr Bennett to draft a media release, Mr Green to talk to local businesses.
