Steventon Parish Council is calling on residents, passionate about their community to stand in the local elections in 2019.

Councillors are the champions of their community and give residents a voice on the decisions the council makes. Becoming a councillor will allow you to make a real difference in your community by engaging with residents, local groups and businesses to find out their needs; making decisions on which services and projects the council should take forward; and getting involved locally to ensure the services are meeting your community's needs.



Parish Council elections will be held on 2nd May if insufficient applications are received there is no election but those nominated automatically become the councillors. Parish Councillors are unpaid and voluntarily give their time and energy for the good of the village and serve for a period of four years. The qualifications are that you are over 18 and either live or work in Steventon and have done for the past twelve months. Full details of qualification and nominations forms are available from:

There will be the Publication of Notice of Election on 26th March. Nomination forms must be submitted to the Vale of White Horse District Council offices, by hand, before 4 pm on Wednesday 3rd April 2019. If you would like I will collect and deliver to the Vale your nomination forms. For more information talk to the current councillors and find out what is involved, some will be standing for re-election.

The Parish Council meets in the Millennium room of the Village Hall on the first Tuesday of each month from 7 pm. Come and see what goes on and have your say in public participation which is at the start of the meeting.
